Parents who register their children early will benefit from two money saving incentives. First, if you register by Feb 29th for 2012-13, you will be locked in at this current year's tuition rate. You will be guaranteed that your tuition rate will not increase. Rates may go up after Feb 29th. Secondly, if you register by Feb 29th, the registration fee is only \$225.00. After Feb 29th, the fee will go up to \$425.00.
